Since 2010, he has been a **fixed-term manager of the Province of Salerno**, with the title of Chief of Cabinet of the Presidency. From 2007 to 2008, he was Professor of History of Public Administration in the Degree Course in Social Service Sciences at the Faculty of Education of the University “Suor Orsola Benincasa” of Naples. He has also held the position of Interim Director of the Legal and Litigation Sector of the Province of Salerno, as well as of General Manager of the Province of Salerno. Since 2012, he has been **President of the Culture, Research, Innovation, Development (CRIS) Foundation**.
