FRANCESCO MARIA LUCREZI is **Full Professor of Roman Law**, of Law of Ancient East-Mediterranean and of History of East-Mediterranean, at the Department of Legal Sciences (School of Law) of the University of Salerno (Italy). From 1987 to 1991, he was Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law of the University of Reggio Calabria, as well as Chair of Roman Administrative Organization and Roman Public Law; from 1991 to 1994, he was Associate Professor of Institutions of Roman Law at the University "G. D'Annunzio" of Chieti. **He was also Director of the Department of Law in Society and History** of the University of Teramo in 1999 and designated with

teaching Roman Law and the Mediterranean East at the Second University of Naples. Boasting a long academic experience, he was charged with Roman and East-Mediterranean Law at the Second University of Naples. In 2005, he was Visiting Professor at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and Affiliated Professor at the University of Haifa. Moreover, from 2008 to 2011 he was appointed to teach Legal Institutions of the Mediterranean at the University "L'Orientale" of Naples and was in charge of Photography and Copyright course at the "Accademia delle Belle Arti" (Art Academy) in Naples from 2008 to 2019. Director of the official journal of the Department of Legal Sciences of the University of Salerno "Iura & Legal Systems" since 2013, he has also been a Member of the Academic Senate at the University of Salerno since 2019 and, since 2018, a Member of Legal Studies department board therein. Additionally, since 2013, he has been Professor of History and Institutions of Roman Law at the University "Suor Orsola Benincasa" of Naples and Professor of Law, Legislation and Economics of Entertainment at the Art Academy of Naples since 2019. Lucrezi is also the author of three monographs entitled "Tito. La
