She was also **member of the Scientific Staff of Jean Monnet European Center of Excellence of the University of Athens**.

Currently, Professor Manoli is an Associate Editor of the Journal *Southeast European and Black Sea Studies* (Routledge/Taylor and Francis) and an Associate Researcher at the Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy. She was also **member of Scientific Staff of Jean Monnet European Center of Excellence of the University of Athens.**
