SERGIO MOCCIA is Emeritus Professor of Criminal Law at the University “Federico II” of Naples. Starting in 1987 as Associate Professor of Criminal Law at the University of Salerno, he was appointed as Substitute Professor of Criminal Law at the University of Reggio Calabria for the 1992-1993 period. Similarly, he also had **academic assignments** as Substitute Professor of Criminal Law at the Department of Legal Sciences of the University of Salerno in 1992-1995; Substitute Professor of Economic Criminal Law in 1995-1996; Substitute Professor of Public Administration Criminal Law in 1996-1997; as well as Substitute Professor of Criminal Law in 1999-2000. Additionally, Prof. Moccia

served as **Director of the Department of International Studies** at the University of Salerno from 1996 to 1999. He then moved to the Faculty of Law at University of Naples where, as Full Professor of Criminal Law, he began to teach in 1999. He later **was appointed as Director of the Department of Criminal, Criminology and Penitentiary Sciences** at the same university for 2009-2012. More than once he was the **winner of scholarships in prestigious institutions** such as *Institut für die gesamten Strafrechtswissenschaften* of Munich (both the “Alexander von Humboldt” and the “Fritz von Thyssen” foundations scholarships), where he also taught as *Gastprofessor* in 1989 and 1993-1994. **He has been Member of Committee for bioethics** of the Campania region (Italy) since 1996 and was part of the Committee for the reform of the Italian Criminal Code, established by the Ministry of Justice in 2006. **Director of the book series** “*Studi di scienze penalistiche integrate*” and “*Nuove ricerche di scienze penalistiche*”, he’s also **director of the journal** “*Critica del diritto*”. Moreover, he’s **author of a number of monographies**, such as: “*Politica criminale e riforma del sistema penale*” (1984); “*Il diritto penale tra essere e valore. Funzione della pena e sistematica teologica*” (1992); “*Diritti dell'uomo e sistema penale*” (2003).
