She is the only Italian member of the <u>Global Health Law Consortium</u>; fellow of the <u>Global Health Law Groningen Research Centre</u> and of the European Scientific Network on Law and Tobacco at the University of Groningen; Associate member of the <u>Instituto Universitario de Estudios Europeos "Salvador de Madariaga"</u>, University of La Coruña; founding member of the EAHL Interest Group on European Supranational Biolaw.

Since 2010 she is the **founder and director of the Observatory on Human Rights: Bioethics, Health, Environment (ODUBSA)**, Prof. Negri is currently a member of the Editorial Committee, guest editor and referee of the International Community Law Review,
