From 2014 to 2017 she was co-responsible of the Jean Monnet Module on "Migration and Fundamental Rights at the Southern Borders of the European Union" and in charge of the sub-module on "The protection of fundamental rights of migrants and asylum seekers in the 'integrated' system of protection (national, European, international)".

She is the only Italian member of the [Global Health Law Consortium](#); fellow of the [Global Health Law Groningen Research Centre](#) and of the European Scientific Network on Law and Tobacco at the University of Groningen; Associate member of the [Instituto Universitario de Estudios Europeos "Salvador de Madariaga"](#), University of La Coruña; founding member of the EAHL Interest Group on European Supranational Biolaw.

Since 2010 she is the **founder and director of the Observatory on Human Rights: Bioethics, Health, Environment (ODUBSA)**, Prof. Negri is currently a member of the Editorial Committee, guest editor and referee of the International Community Law Review,
