JONAS NILSSON has more than 20 years of working experience in the fields of international criminal law, international human rights, international humanitarian law, and refugee law.

Mr. Nilsson **has working and consultancy experience from several international courts and tribunals**, including the International Criminal Court, the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts in Cambodia, the Kosovo Specialist Chambers, and the Special Tribunal for Lebanon. Between 2005 and 2017, **he worked in ICTY Chambers** (pre-trial, trial, and appeal-stage), managing a team of legal officers. The cases he worked on include the Haradinaj et al. case, the Gotovina et al. case, and the Stanišić and

Simatović case. Between 2011 and 2017, Mr. Nilsson was the Senior Legal Officer and team leader of the legal team supporting the Judges on the Mladić case (see <http://www.internationalcrimesdatabase.org/Commentary/IcdBriefs2018>). He previously worked with human rights and refugee law at Amnesty International and the Swedish Helsinki Committee (Civil Rights Defenders). Between 2001 and 2003, Mr. Nilsson lived in Kosovo and **worked at the Ombudsperson Institution as Legal Officer** and Director of Investigations.

During the last 20 years, He has **lectured and published extensively on international criminal law and human rights**. Furthermore, he was a member of the editorial committee of the Journal of International Criminal Justice for more than 10 years. Since January 2019, He was the co-editor for Commentary on the Law of the International Criminal Court, together with Professor Mark Klamberg (<https://www.cilrap-lexsitus.org/clicc>). His previous publications include articles for the Oxford Companion to International Criminal Justice (Antonio Cassese, Ed.) and in distinguished journals, including the American Journal of International Law and the Nordic Journal of International Law.
