ANTONINO SESSA is Full Professor of Criminal Law and Juvenile Criminal Law, both Preliminary notions and Crime notions courses at the Department of Legal Sciences (School of Law) of the University of Salerno. He also teaches Criminal Procedural Law at the Pontifical Lateran University in Rome and he is Professor of Criminal Law at the School of Specialization for Legal Professions at both the University of Salerno and University “Federico II” of Naples. He was also student at the *Institut für die gesamten Strafrechtswissenschaften*, University “Ludwig Maximilians” of Munich, Germany, where he perfected his studies. Prof Sessa **took part to the National Research Council and departmental research projects in criminal law, criminal**

procedure, criminology and commercial law. Furthermore, he was member of the committee for the elaboration of a proposal to reform Art. 2621 of the Italian Civil Code. He is **member of the Scientific Committee of the Criminology, Criminal and Criminal Procedure Law Sciences Biennial Specialization Course**, named after Prof. Andrea Antonio Dalia and directed by Prof. Luigi Kalb. Since 2008, **he has been appointed for the continuous formation of managers at the Higher School of Public Administration of Salerno** and at the Italian Ministry of Home Affairs, Department for Home and Local Affairs. He is **member of the “Diritto e Giustizia minorile” journal Scientific Committee, as well as member of the reviewing committee of the “Critica del diritto” journal.** Prof. Sessa **has published many volumes and articles in specialized journals, such as “Cassazione Penale”.** He is also **coordinator of several research projects** within the Department of Legal Sciences (School of Law) of the University of Salerno and funded by the latter. Until 2027, he used to be Erasmus+ project coordinator for the Department of Legal Sciences (School of Law) with the Heinrich-Heine University of Düsseldorf, Germany.
